GROUP CAMP & SLEEPOVER AT BLACKWELL COURT

Dear Parent

We're taking the Beavers, Cubs and Scouts on our Sleepover and Camp at Blackwell Court Scout Centre near Bromsgrove, from Friday 19th to Sunday 21st May.

Beavers will be sleeping **indoors** in bunk-beds in the Pod Village, 4 in each pod. We've organised a full programme of fun and activities, which includes climbing, obstacle course, archery, pedal karts, games and much more.

Beavers have the option: - Arrive on Friday night and stay 2 nights *or*Arrive on the Saturday morning and stay 1 night.

Arrive: Either 7.30pm on Friday or 10.00am on Saturday

Finishing: 2.30 pm on Sunday.

We invite parents and families to join us at this time for tea and cake on the lawns. Parents are welcome to bring a picnic and bring picnic chairs
