

RESIDENTIAL PACK HOLIDAY AT BLACKWELL COURT

Dear Parent

We're taking the Cubs on Pack Holiday to Blackwell Court Scout Centre near Bromsgrove from **Friday 15th to Sunday 17th November**.

We'll be staying in the heated Manor House, sleeping in dormitories with beds, and have a full weekend of activities planned.

The theme for the weekend will be Spy School with secret missions, codes, disguises and much more. Outside we'll be going on the 3G swing, Tree Trek, Laser Tag, nightline, confidence course and much more..



Here are the full details if your child wishes to go:

Arrive: **At 7.30 pm on Friday 15th at Blackwell Court.** We ask parents to bring Cubs to Blackwell. Please arrive in uniform – sweatshirt and necker – if you have one

Leaving: **At 2.30 pm on Sunday.** We ask parents to collect Cubs from Blackwell.

Cost: The cost will be £100.

We have done everything we can to keep this cost down, but the Manor House costs £60 per person for accommodation. The rest is for food and all the activities.

No Cub should be prevented from going because of the cost. If there are any financial problems, please don't hesitate to let us know, in full confidence of course.

Kit: A kit list is attached for guidance. You can also find it at www.romsleyscouts.org.uk

- We suggest bringing **old** clothes. Cubs will need warm & waterproof clothes for outdoors and something comfortable for indoors.
- They will need wellies for walking and old footwear for activities (wellies are unsuitable for the activities).
- Cubs will also need a sleeping bag or duvet & bottom sheet, and a pillow.
- Please ensure that all items of kit are marked with name or initials.

- **Important - Cubs must be able to pack their own kit bag.** Please show them how to do this, as they will need to pack their kit by themselves during the weekend.
- Please do not overfill bags. Sleeping bags/duvets can be put in bin liners.

Pocket Money There will be a chance to buy drinks, sweets and souvenirs.

Health & Food: We'll send out health forms nearer the date. In the meantime, please let us know if you child has any specific requirements, such as vegetarian or food allergies.
